CHÂTEAU BOYREIN *AOC Graves Rouge 2015*

Château Boyrein, “Wood of the Queen,” was once the domain of the lords of Gournes and was also said to be the hunting lodge of Pope Clement V. The estate was dismantled in 1877. The Medeville family has since been committed to its restoration for three generations. This magnificent estate, surrounded by woods and covering 13 hectares of vines in the commune of Roaillan, is located on a beautiful gravel hillside facing south and south-west.

GRAPE VARIETIES:	40% Cabernet Sauvignon 10% Cabernet Franc 50% Merlot
AGE OF VINES:	35 years old
VINE DENSITY:	6,666 vines per hectare
HARVEST:	manual
VINIFICATION:	Hand sorting, daily <i>remontages</i> , with slow fermentation in stainless steel at low temperature for 15 to 25 days to retain fruit freshness. Bottled at the château.
PRODUCTION:	45,000 bottles
